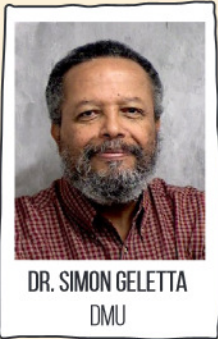




KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



HUNGER IN CENTRAL IOWA

Dr. Simon Geletta is a Ph.D. and associate professor at DMU. His research includes the evaluation, design and analysis of health education disease prevention programs. He will share his current work collecting bi-monthly data on hunger in Polk, Dallas, and Warren counties.



URBAN FOOD SYSTEMS DESIGN

Jason Grimm is a farmer and Food System Planner at Iowa Valley RC&D. His masters thesis in landscape architecture at Iowa State University was on Food Urbanism, and he was a key architect of Iowa's Farm to School program. He will share what is possible in designing urban food systems.

DIRECTIONS

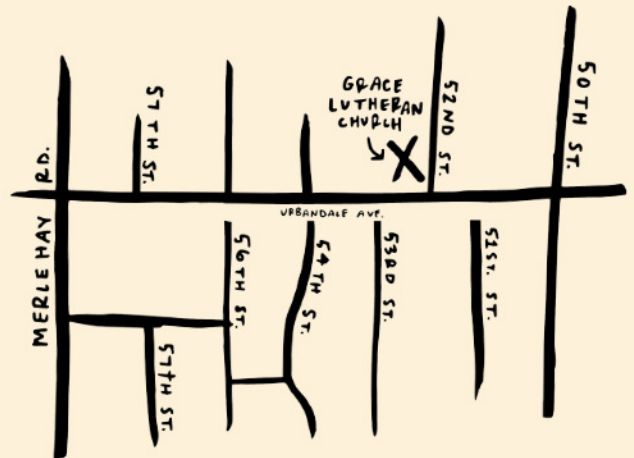
